JOINT CONGRESS ON MECHANICAL VIBRATION AND TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATIONS IN HEALTH (MEVITIH-2024)

The Scientific Committee of the Joint Congress on Mechanical Vibration and Technological Innovations in Health (MEVITIH-2024) has the honor of inviting students, professionals, professors, and researchers specializing in topics related to mechanical vibration and technological innovations in health to submit abstracts to be presented at the congress, after approval by peer review. MEVITIH-2024 will take place at Policlínica Universitária Piquet Carneiro, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil between November 6th and 8th, 2024.

1 – INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING ABSTRACTS

- Abstracts must be written in English, in accordance with current written language standards.
- The abstracts submitted must consist of original work in progress or finished, in the form of scientific abstracts, case report or experience report.
- Literature review works or projects that have not yet started will not be accepted.
- The title must contain a maximum of 200 characters.
- The main author must be listed as first author. The supervisor of the work must be listed as the last author. All authors cited in the abstract must be registered in MEVITIH-2024.
- Each registration allows the submission of up to two (2) abstracts, in which the registrant must be an author or co-author. The same researcher may be co-author of other abstracts. The limit of authors per abstract is ten (10). The deadline for submitting abstracts is August 16, 2024.

Thematic areas: focal and systemic mechanical vibration, integrative and complementary practices, palliative care, regenerative therapy, technological innovation in diagnosis and therapy, technological innovation in surgical practices, translational research, among others related to the subject of the MEVITIH-2024.

2 - INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING THE SUMMARY

Abstracts must be submitted according to the Summary Model in the link <https://vibmecbio.com/submisson/>. The abstract must contain a title, followed by the authors' names with respective affiliation(s), body of the text, keywords, and support/acknowledgments (optional), exactly as indicated in the template. Abstracts outside the established standard will not be considered.

File Information:

Source: Times New Roman

Title size: 10

Size others: 9

Title characters (with space): up to 200 characters (without abbreviations [example: COPD], in bold with text in ALL CAPS).

Characters (no spaces): up to 2000 characters (excluding title, names, affiliations, keywords and support/acknowledgments).

Affiliations: maximum two (2) for each author.

Single paragraph

Space between lines: single spacing.

Keywords: three to four (3-4 keywords).

Corresponding author: must be marked with an asterisk (*).

Do not include tables, figures or graphs in the abstract.

Content:

Introduction: present a summary of the topic.

Objective: The aim of the study.

Methods: Briefly describe the methods used in the study.

Results: Present the main findings, including any relevant statistical data.

Conclusion: Summarize the main conclusions and the relevance of the study.

3 - INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING ABSTRACTS

- The abstract may be sent by the main author or by one of the co-authors, as long as they are duly registered for the event. The author responsible for submitting the abstracts must also be responsible for all the information contained therein, attesting to the agreement of all co-authors.
- The abstract will be sent exclusively by email (abstractsmevitih2024@gmail.com), in Portable Document Format (.pdf) until 23:59 on August 16, 2024.
- When submitting, the subject of the email must include the name of the main author, the title of the study and thematic area. Abstracts that do not meet the aforementioned requirements will not be considered for evaluation.
- The approved abstracts will be posted by email and on the event website in September 2024 (<https://vibmecbio.com/congress/>). After acceptance, authors must prepare the poster in Power Point (.ppt) format (Item 4).
- Once submitted, the information in the abstract cannot be changed or modified in the poster, maintaining the information originally sent.

4 - INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING THE POSTER

Please be advised that the poster session will take place throughout the event (from November 6th to 8th, 2024). The exchange of information between the authors and the event participants will take place in person during the congress or via the email address provided by the authors, if the doubts are not resolved.

Content:

Introduction: present a summary of the topic.

Objective: Define the aim of the study.

Methods: Briefly describe the methods used in the study.

Results: Present the main findings, including any relevant statistical data.

Conclusion: Summarize the main conclusions and the relevance of the study.

References: list of references used to prepare the text (3 to 5 references). Only provide the DOI of the publication.

You may include tables, figures or graphs in the poster.

5 - POSTER EVALUATION COMMITTEE

- The Scientific Committee of the Joint Congress on Mechanical Vibration and Technological Innovations in Health (MEVITIH-2024) will invite the members of the poster evaluation committee.
- When evaluating the posters, the following items will be considered: writing and structure, originality, methods, results, impact and relevance in health.
- The committee will select the 3 (three) best posters.

6 – AWARDS

The 3 (three) best posters will be awarded with a certificate of honorable mention at the end of the congress.

7 – PUBLICATION

The approved abstracts will be published in the online Brazilian Journal of Mechanical Vibrations in Biosciences (BJMVB) [ISSN 2965-9671] after (1) one month of the event.

8 - CERTIFICATE

The author who carried out the submission of the abstract actually presented in the MEVITIH-2024 will receive a certificate of abstract presentation by e-mail. This certificate will be available, within a period of up to four (4) months after the end of the Joint Congress on Mechanical Vibration and Technological Innovations in Health.
